Senior Prom Policy

(Adopted: 9/20/2005)

PURPOSE:

This policy is designed to identify the requirements to attend the Iroquois Junior-Senior Prom.

GUIDELINES:

1. Students must purchase a ticket to attend the prom. The prom advisor and the prom committee will determine ticket price.
2. In order to purchase a ticket, students must be juniors or seniors (11th or 12th grade) attending Iroquois High School.
3. Sophomore (10th grade) may attend the prom only as a guest of and accompanied by an Iroquois junior or senior student.
4. Freshmen (9th grade) and below are not permitted to attend the prom under any circumstances. Prom committee members that are in grade 9 that are assigned to work the prom collecting tickets or serving refreshments may do so under the direction of the prom advisor.
5. Students must attend school the day before the prom is held to be eligible to attend. The administration may approve certain circumstances.
6. Students from other school districts, in grades 10, 11, or 12 may attend only as a guest and accompanied by an Iroquois High School junior or senior student attending the prom. They must also provide verification from their high school administration in the form of a letter stating that they are in good standing at their present school. Students not attending high school must have approval from the high school administration in order to attend.
7. Students suspended from school or attending an alternative education program as a result of disciplinary action may not attend the prom.
