Starting at the entrance to Presque Isle State Park, Erie Pennsylvania

A 12.5-mile loop around scenic Presque Isle

1<sup>st</sup> rider leaves at 8:00 a.m., others at 15-second intervals

Proceeds benefit the Iroquois School District Foundation

## **SUMMARY OF REGULATIONS**

1. Helmets are mandatory.
2. Drafting, motor pacing can result in disqualification. Absolutely no support personnel of any kind. (Children in the 9-and-under age group may have an adult ride behind them).
3. Riders must check into the starting line 5 minutes before their start time. No rolling starts. Riders missing their start time – no re-registration will be allowed.
4. Absolutely no rider substitutions will be allowed.
5. Riders are not allowed to cross the finish line in the right lane of traffic while warming up or down.
6. Riders must stay in the right-hand lane throughout the entire course.
7. Bicycles must have two functional brakes or coaster brake.
8. Bicycles may have extended handlebars (i.e. DH style), spoke covers (on front and rear) but no other aerodynamic fairing devices (windshields, etc.) that are not an integral part of the frame. Discs that replace spokes, aerodynamically designed components such as aeroframes, handlebars, pedals, spokes, rims, brakes, helmets, clothes, etc. are acceptable.
9. Bike numbers must be returned to the Registration Table in the award area to receive shirt.
10. Failure to mark shirt size on the application will result in an X-Large for males and Large for females.

## **IMPORTANT DEADLINES**

April 5<sup>th</sup> - Applications must be postmarked on or before this date in order to receive a shirt.

April 5<sup>th</sup> - Awards ordered based on the number of entrants per age division by this date.

April 12<sup>th</sup> - Applications postmarked on or before this date – \$25 donation.

April 14<sup>th</sup> - Applications postmarked on this date or later – \$30 donation.

April 19<sup>th</sup> - Applications must be received on or before this date.

April 21<sup>st</sup> - Start times mailed to all riders.

You should receive your start time in the mail by April 25<sup>th</sup>.
